

Dear FLI/Coaching System Instructor,

After 11 years of use as an approved driving curriculum in the State of Ohio for 8-Hour Adult Remedial classes, I am proud to announce that the FLI/Coaching Systems Coaching the Experienced Driver 4+2 is being replaced with the updated *Coaching the Experienced Driver 3 Ohio Version (CED3)*. The State of Ohio has reviewed and approved the changes to the curriculum. All driving schools will have until September 2012 to make the transition and be in compliance with the new curriculum.

Driving schools currently using the 4+2 Curriculum will be required to attend a one-day program which will include a new CED3 instructor kit. The instructor kit contains leader's guide and updated DVD.

The one-day required program will be held on scheduled dates on a monthly basis at the Safety Council of Northwest Ohio. Additionally, 3-day Train the Trainer programs have been scheduled for schools not currently using the FLI/Coaching Systems Program or schools currently using the FLI/Coaching Systems program who would like to add certified instructors.

The cost to purchase the CED3 instructor kit is \$375.00. Schools with multiple instructors that do not have the need for additional DVDs can purchase a leader guide without the DVD for \$145.00. Please note that each school must have at least one full instructor kit.

Upon completion of the one-day program, attendees will receive certificates of completion that can be used toward continuing education requirements and a new instructor certificate indicating certification for the CED3 program, along with the CED instructor kit.

Enclosed are registration forms with the dates and times for the one-day instructor update classes and the 3-day Train-The-Trainer classes.

Pre-registration and pre-payment a week prior to the start of the class is required to receive this fee. Students not pre-registered will be charged an additional \$100.00.
