In Loco Parentis Affidavit

(Revised Code Section 4507.05, 4507.21)

The In Loco Parentis Affidavit must be obtained from a DX Supervisor by the parent, if they need to pursue this option.

This form is to be used when the temporary instruction permit holder is between 15-1/2 and 16-years-old and is to be accompanied while driving by a responsible adult 21 years of age or older who acts in loco parentis (fulfilling parental responsibilities in the absence of a parent, guardian, or custodian).

The parent, guardian, or custodian must state under oath that all of the following are true:

1. I am the parent (or guardian or custodian, if applicable) of a minor between the age of 15-½ and 16-years-old who is the holder of a temporary permit.
2. I understand that the minor needs to be accompanied while driving by a responsible adult 21 years of age or older who acts in loco parentis (fulfilling parental responsibilities in the absence of a parent, guardian, or custodian).
3. No parent (or guardian or custodian, if applicable) is available because one or both of the following apply: (a) there is no parent residing in Ohio who has a valid driver's license, or (b) the parent with a valid driver's license is physically unable to accompany the minor while driving.
4. I as parent (or guardian or custodian, if applicable) have cosigned for the minor to receive his or her temporary instruction permit.
5. I consent to the following person, who is related to the minor by blood or marriage, to accompany the minor while driving.

The information requested about the eligible adult must be provided, and the form notarized.
